2019 Munster Mints Day Camp - Program Descriptions

Monday, July 22 Drop off begins at 8:30 a.m. - Pick up at 4:30 p.m. Drop off/pick up location- Center for Visual and Performing Arts (CVPA), rehearsal room lower level (Munster, IN). We will be doing activities at the CVPA and at Heritage Park: making catapults, painting a Girl Scout sign, garden redo/spruce up at Heritage Park, a candy hunt, games, and songs. Service Project is towels for the Muster Fire Department (bath size or larger).

Tuesday, July 23 and Wednesday, July 24 Drop off begins at 8:30 a.m. – Pick up at 4:00 p.m. Drop off/pick up location- CVPA back of parking lot. Our journey takes us to Iron Oaks in Olympia Fields for badge workshops by level- Daisies Use Resources Wisely, Brownies Hiker, Juniors Eco Camper, and Cadettes Trees. Then we will head to Friendship Center, Country Club Hills for our overnight. Each level will have one badge workshop: Daisies Designing Robots, Brownies Computer Expert, Juniors Entertainment Tech, and Cadettes MEdia Journey (plus Silver Award Training). Juniors and Cadettes will also participate in archery. Other activities will be a movie, s'mores, crafts, games and songs. Service project will be bottled water for the homeless.

Wednesday, July 24 to Thursday, July 25 for Cadettes and Program aides only

Wednesday afternoon we will leave the Homewood Metra train station and head to Chicago, staying overnight at the HI Chicago Hostel. We will be cooking dinner, watching the Wednesday night fireworks at Navy Pier and Thursday having an Art Institute adventure. We will travel back by train to the Hammond South Shore train station. Pick up time will be in the confirmation packet.
